General Information

Evaluation

The CBSE has issued Circular No. Acad05/2017 dated 31-01-2017 on the restoration of Board Examination for class X and revised assessment structure and examination for class X from academic Year 2017-18 onward. This new scheme will bring the uniformity in the system of assessment and examination for classes IX and X in all the CBSE affiliated schools. To increase the confidence in the students to start preparing for class X Board examination when they join the upper primary stage. The CBSE has decided to implement the uniform system of assessment, examination pattern. While keeping in view the provisions of Right to education Act, 2009, the scheme has been designed on Term Assessment basis with gradual increase in the Learning assessment as the students move forward. This would prepare the students to cover the whole syllabus of the academic year and face the challenge of class X board examination and would thus, ensure the 'quality of education'.

The assessment structure and examination have been prepared in view of the provisions of RTE-ACT 2009 and comprises of two terms i.e. Term-1 and 2 as explained below :-

Discipline (Classes VI-VIII)

The students will also be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behaviour, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others, grading on Discipline will be done term-wise on a 3-point grading scale (A=outstanding, B=Very good and C=Fair)

- * In case there happens to be a holiday on a particular exam date, the exam will be held as per the intimation given by school
- * Each student should have 75% of attendance in each term to be eligible to appear in Term/Summative exam.
- * In order to pass, each student has to secure 40% marks
- * The student will be promoted to the next class on the basis of final result.
- * It is mandatory for each student to appear in all the PTs & Term exams. No retest will be conducted if a student misses PT for any reason, Absent (AB) will be marked. Retest is permissible for Term exam. only depending upon the situation.
- * In case a student misses the exam due to chronic illness, parents are requested to inform the Principal/HM in writing and submit a medical certificate to that effect not later than two days after the particular examination. The case will be examined by the medical officer and decision w.r.t. conduction of re-test will be taken by the examination committee.
- * The subjects of Sanskrit/M.S./Health & Physical Edu., G.K. Art education, Computer will be assessed term wise.
